NEW CAMPER HOUSING IN 2018:

Seven dry cabins will be a new option in the summer of 2018 to house campers. The cabins, which have electricity but no plumbing, are located around the lodges. Each cabin holds a total of 12 campers. This fall, thanks to volunteers that have been on-site and those from local churches, a total of five cabins are nearing completion. The final two cabins have the floors laid and are ready to be completed in the spring. The cabins will replace the tents that have been used for several years. Bathroom facilities for the new cabins will be shared with the existing lodges.

CONFERENCE CENTER: A major construction project took place this fall with the installation of what is called a "cold roof" over the entire Conference Center. Thanks to the work of Hill Construction out of Boise, led by dedicated camp partner, Steve Hill, the project is nearing completion. The cold roof is basically a roof over the existing roof that will prevent the build up of ice dams and large icicles on the building.
