You will note **there is a new camp in 2023**. The 4th-6th Girls and Boys camp have asked to combine the two camps together. Their reasons were the following:

1. Parents want campers at those ages to be together to avoid using two weeks when family vacation could take place
2. Children's Pastors supported the idea since they have many summer activities and it is difficult for a male pastor to be at Girls Camp and female pastors to be at Boys Camp. This way they will be together.
3. A greater synergy and excitement for camp. Larger services, combined speakers, and music opportunities.
4. Many events will still be separated even down to special meals that might be planned.
5. Allows parents to both be counselors in the same week, especially if they have campers in that age range.
