Unfortunately, these are not unique challenges; you and I have been dealing with these same issues in our daily lives.

- Restaurants and businesses closed frequently because of staff issues
- · Lack of menu items and empty shelves of a product we wish to purchase
- Increase in the cost of menu and food items in restaurants and grocery stores
- · Lack of services, technicians, repair folks

When you put these factors in place in a small, remote community like Cascade, you can began to see the picture. If I can't get a repairman in the Boise area to take care of a problem, I am definitely going to have challenges getting them to come all the way to Cascade.

Please pray for us as we work through these challenges. If you know of people available to volunteer or work on weekends at the camp during our retreat season, please contact the camp in Cascade directly at 208-382-6200. Most importantly, pray for the health and safety of those that are at the camp and that we can get folks to step forth to help us meet some of these needs.
