REMODEL OF THE 7 BUNKHOUSES | NEW RESTROOM | STAFF HOUSING ABOVE NEW RESTROOM

We are excited with a new project at Trinity Pines that was launched at Share the Dream on December 1, 2022. Here is a quick summary of some details:

BUNKHOUSES: The seven bunkhouses were constructed to replace the tents that were used for several years as seasonal housing. The bunkhouses were rudimentary with no insulation, limited electricity, etc. However, the bunkhouses have proven to be popular with some upgrades. The remodel plan includes insulation, HVAC units (much like a hotel) and additional electricity. This will extend the use into early spring and late fall in a more climate-controlled environment.

RESTROOMS: The construction of the bunkhouses put strain on the capacity of the lodge restrooms. This project will construct a new restroom complete with showers, sinks, and toilets to handle the bunkhouse guests. The restroom will also meet the needs of the worship tent and amphitheater guests where we have been using portable restrooms. The restroom facility will have a new design to accommodate family restrooms and meet some specific needs.

STAFF HOUSING: The committee that worked on the restroom reminded the board that going up with a building is much more cost effective than going out, so the decision was to add some additional staff housing above the restroom. The last three summers have proved the need for more housing for volunteers who have helped operate the camp. Many of our volunteers are willing to come but do not have RV's and need housing. Because of the size of many of our camps we cannot afford to give up prime housing (lodges, cottages, etc.) for volunteers, so we must continue to look for alternatives. The housing above the restroom will be similar to what we have constructed above two of the lodges.

Elk Valley Project Cost:

Bunkhouse Remodel: \$8,000/bunkhouse

To date, we have generated \$28,400. This amount gives us a great start on 3.5 bunkhouses with a goal of completing all 7 bunkhouses.

Restroom Facility: \$500.000-\$600.000

Ranges depending upon the amount of donated material and volunteer labor. The goal of this project is to generate \$300,000 from our Camp Partners and Churches and then apply for a matching Murdock Foundation Grant.
