It appears from Early Bird Registrations for Summer Camps that we could rebound from the past two years. On Friday, May 13, we had a total of 741 campers registered compared to June 4 of last year, when we had 757. This indicates that we are going to have a crowd. Now, the problem is we are short on staff, interns, and volunteers to meet the needs of these campers. The main areas of need include: food service, housekeeping, programs, laundry, and general labor.

We have not pushed the panic button at this time, but we are aware of where it is located. We had hoped for 6-8 college interns and we have one. We had hoped to hire 3-5 people from the community in a variety of areas and we have been unsuccessful with more "Help Wanted" signs posted in the Cascade area each week as they anticipate the change in the season and visitors coming to the Heartland of Idaho.

If you are interested in volunteering or seeking employment in a summer Christian Camp environment, please call the camp office ASAP (208-382-6200) and speak with Manager Tyler Luschen. If you know of young people between the ages of 16-18 that would like to apply for the SALT (Servant and Leadership Training) program or high school graduates that are interested in working for the summer (late May through early August) let us know. Both of these positions are compensated financially.

The Lord has blessed us with children and teens who want to camp. Now, we must step up and meet the challenge of having enough staff to take care of their needs. Please be in prayer about this critical situation at Trinity Pines. Help us spread the word. From our end, we have posted information in various locations, visited college and university campuses and high schools, and still have not found the unique individuals who are motivated by a summer of ministry. We always appreciate volunteers who have RVs for housing, but we have continued to expand and build apartments for volunteers. We look forward to hearing from you.

MATTRESS REPLACEMENT PROGRAM: At Share the Dream, we rolled out the campaign to replace 100 mattresses at camp. We were not expecting supply chain challenges along the way, but finally all the mattresses have arrived. Each replacement mattress costs \$300. We went with a firmer mattress to accommodate adult guests. The total project cost with shipping is \$30,051. Prior to District Assembly, we had raised \$10,700, leaving a balance of \$19,351. Enclosed you will find a pledge card to assist us in covering the costs of the mattresses. Thanks to those at Assembly who helped in the mattress campaign; we received over \$3,300 toward the project. I hope you can help us reach our goal. The mattresses we replaced were originally purchased when we opened the camp over 20 years ago.

REGISTRATON DEADLINES: Remember, **June 1** is the final registration for all June Camps (Genesis, Sr. High, and Boy's) and **July 1** is the final registration for all July Camps (Jr High and Girl's). We no longer allow walk-ons at summer camps. Please be aware of these deadlines.
