Jay Akkerman

Jay Akkerman serves at NNU as the Assistant to the President for Congregational Engagement. In his role, he extends NNU's relationship with pastors and congregations across the Northwest Educational Field using a variety of channels and deepens connections with those from other traditions beyond the Church of the Nazarene. Jay has been with NNU since 2003, most recently serving as Dean of Graduate and Professional Studies and Director of the Graduate School of Theology.
